What have you been up to since the release of *Everready*?

I have been touring and in the middle of the touring I got this idea to do a mixtape/compilation with all original music. It will be out July 17th! We started it March 30th and it is the quickest album I ever did because we finished it on April 26th. I got solo songs on there too and on top of that I am on every song. We leaked a little bit of it to let people know what it will sound like.

What about your next solo album?

start on that one right before November and we will probably drop it right before next Summer. I feel right now after "Killer" that I wont do anymore solo albums. After killer I am going to Kabosh and then I am done because I want to chill with my family. I have sacrificed a lot for the music and I just got "Sacrifice" tatted across my chest last night at two in the morning so it is burning like hell right now.

I love the song "Welcome To My World" that you did with Brotha Lynch!

Lynch is incredible. I wanted all my fans and the rest of the world to know that he is an extreme talent. That song was originally suppose to be me, him, and Eminem but Eminem couldn't make it because he had so many tragedies happening in his life at that time. We both have good fanbases but I want the rest of the world to know about him just like me because I feel we deserve that man.

Is there anything else homie?

Go out and pick up *MLK* which stands for *Misery Loves Company The Tech N9ne Colabos* on July 17th. Also look out for the Strange Noise Tour with Kotton Mouth Kings, Tech N9ne, Sub Noise Soldiers, Blaze Ya Dead Homie and More and it starts July 6th in Albuquerque and we will be gone all the way until September. This tour will be crazy. We are doing big tours and the VIP packages are going out like crazy. It is insanity at its finest!
